THE MALAYSIAN SANGHA FUND

Brief Introduction

The Malaysian Sangha Fund was launched on 25th August 1991 during the first Maha Sanghikadana organised by the Yayasan at the Penang Chinese Town Hall, Pitt Street, Penang. The proceeds of the Maha Sanghikadana are channeled into the Sangha Fund with the main objective of supporting the welfare of the Malaysian Sangha, thus an opportunity for Buddhist devotees to support the Sangha through this fund.

The Fund is managed by a committee consisting of Chao Khun Phra Raj Dhammathada (Chairman), Ven. Phra Kru Pannya Sasananurak (Vice Chairman), Ven. Boon Keng (Vice-Chairman), Ven. Chi Chern (Vice Chairman), Ven. Phra Khru Siddhikhanarak Chamriang Candano (Hon. Secretary), and two lay representatives from the Yayasan Management Board.

The Committee which started operation in early 1992 has:

- Offered annual scholarship to monks and nuns studying in various places;
- Offered book-prizes to student-monks of the Malaysian Buddhist Institute annually;
- Offered financial aid to needy local resident monks while hospitalized;
- Offered requisites to temples in remote areas;
- Sponsored various projects for the activities of the Sangha youth.

Total expenses to-date amounting to RM1,958,362.54 were financed by the Malaysian Sangha Fund since its operation in the year 1992. We hope that with the support of the Buddhist community, more can be done for the welfare of the Malaysian Sangha.
